

**BROADWAY STRIPING MODIFICATIONS  
BETWEEN 16<sup>th</sup> AND 20<sup>th</sup> STREETS  
FROM November 27, 2023 TO January 19, 2024  
8AM to 5PM daily, Monday through Friday.**

**Expect Delays due to Reduced Lanes and No Street Parking (Temporary)**

Dear Neighbors:

The City of Santa Monica hired Excel Paving to modify the striping of **Broadway between 16<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> streets**. Work is scheduled **starting Monday, November 27 through Friday, January 19, 2024**. The contractor will modify the existing pavement striping, remove vertical deflectors and bike lane dividers, and install new vertical deflectors within the modified striping. There will be temporary traffic and street parking closures. The operation of heavy equipment will be necessary and there will be periods of intermittent loud noise during the construction. The City appreciates your patience during these capital improvement projects.






- **Temporary street closures will be in effect Monday through Friday.**
- **Parking restrictions (temporary no parking signs) in the area will be posted accordingly in the work areas affected.**
- **Driveway access will be limited for entry or exit during the street closures.**
- Detour signs will be posted to direct drivers to alternative routes.
- The roadway will be tabbed with temporary safety markers to indicate lane locations.
- Permanent roadway markings will be installed as soon as the previously installed markings are removed.

Thank you in advance for your patience and cooperation. The City understands this process is inconvenient and staff will make every effort to minimize the disruption. Please contact Fabio M. # BROADWAY PROTECTED BIKE LANE PROJECT

## UPCOMING DESIGN MODIFICATIONS FROM 16TH TO 20TH STREETS

### Project Background

In May 2020, the City upgraded the bike lanes on Broadway between 16th to 20th streets to protected. This short stretch has served as a pilot to the upcoming protected bike lanes from 5th to 26th streets.

Since installation, staff has observed travel behavior and collected feedback from the community. As a result, the City will be making adjustments to the design in early 2024 to improve access and comfort for all users of the street. The following elements will be adjusted from 16th to 20th streets.

### Adjust Parking Lane Widths



- Adjust the width of the parking lane and bike lane to make it more comfortable to enter/exit vehicles next to moving traffic.
- Remove rubber parking stops along bike buffer and replace with plastic posts.

### Add Loading Zones and Green Paint



- Install loading zones at childcare facilities to improve access during drop-off/pick-up.
- Add green paint at mixing zones where pedestrians and bicyclists cross to increase awareness.

### Increase Visibility at Intersections



- Lengthen red curb, also known as “daylighting”, near alleys and driveways to remove obstructions and improve visibility.
- Some parking will be lost as part of this improvement.
