Draft Santa Monica Program Participant Eligibility Criteria

General Santa Monica Program Participant (SMPP) Eligibility Criteria

- An Individual or household with a permanent address at which they currently reside in Santa Monica; or
- A student who currently attends a Santa Monica K-12 public school (for school-based services).

Eligibility Criteria for Santa Monica Program Participants (SMPP) Experiencing Homelessness

- An individual/household experiencing homelessness whose last permanent address at which they resided was in Santa Monica; or
- An individual/adult-only household experiencing homelessness who has been in Santa Monica for at least three years; or
- A family with at least one minor child experiencing homelessness who has been in Santa Monica for at least one year; or
- An individual/household experiencing homelessness referred by City staff as a high utilizer of City services; or
- An individual experiencing homelessness who currently works in Santa Monica a minimum of thirty (30) hours per week for at least six (6) continuous months; or
- An individual experiencing homelessness who, within the past year, was terminated or laid off from a job in Santa Monica after having worked there a minimum of thirty (30) hours per week for at least six (6) continuous months.

Exceptions to Eligibility Criteria

OUTREACH SERVICES

- An individual or adult-only household experiencing homelessness in Santa Monica for any period may be eligible for outreach services.

CITY-OWNED SHELTER BEDS

- A transition-age youth (TAY) (ages 18-25) experiencing homelessness in Santa Monica for at least one year may be eligible for City-owned shelter beds.
- An individual/adult-only household experiencing homelessness that meets the following criteria may be eligible for City-owned shelter beds:

SMPP according to the above criteria	Must meet all the following conditions: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Disabled• VI-SPDAT score of 8+ or LA-HAT score of 12+• Homeless in the City for one year or more• Currently/were served by a City-based Multi-Disciplinary Team (MDT)

Note: Staff may revise the eligibility criteria at any point to respond to emerging needs.
