Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

Although not a "Project" under CEQA, the action is the May 9, 2023 approval of a Settlement Agreement between the City of Santa Monica and WS Communities, LLC, consistent with the City's adopted 6th Cycle (2021-2029) Housing Element for 13 projects and applicants that have asserted eligibility for processing under the "Builder's Remedy" provision of the Housing Accountability Act. The settlement allows for expedited processing of projects subject to the processes and standards already approved pursuant to the Housing Element and implementing ordinances, settles pending litigation between the parties, allows for a transfer of a deed restriction for twenty affordable housing units from 1560 Lincoln Boulevard to 1038/1042 10th Street, and outlines a potential optional ordinance that the City may adopt in its sole and absolute discretion providing certain enhanced benefits including an onsite market rate density bonus if the projects' affordable units are provided offsite at 15%, and the ability to modify Downtown Community Plan's maximum parking standards.
