

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a regular meeting of the Measure GS Oversight Committee will be held at 6:00PM on August 4, 2025 at 330 Olympic Drive, 2nd Floor, Santa Monica Institute (SMI) Room, Santa Monica, CA 90401, for the purpose of only conducting the following business:

Levine Act Disclosure. Pursuant to the Levine Act (Govt Code Section 84308), any party to a permit, license, contract, or other entitlement before the Measure GS Oversight Committee is required to disclose on the record any contribution, including aggregated contributions, of more than \$500 made by the party or the party's agents within the preceding 12 months to any City official. Participants and agents are requested to make this disclosure as well. The disclosure must include the name of the party, participant, or agent, and any other person making the contribution; the name of the recipient, the amount of the contribution, and the date the contribution was made.

(1) Written public comment: The public is encouraged to submit written public comment on agenda items via email to hhs@santamonica.gov. Written public comment submitted before 12:00 pm on the day of the meeting will be available for




online viewing. Please note the agenda item number and letter in the subject line of your written comments.

(2) Oral public comment: Additionally, oral public comment on agenda items can be given in person during the meeting. Oral public comments have a 2-minute time limit per speaker, with a maximum of 6 minutes per meeting. Under some circumstances the Measure GS Oversight Committee may limit this time further.


Please note that Agenda Items may be reordered during the meeting at the discretion of the body.
