



CRIME

Incident	Location	Details
SWAT Call-Out / Barricaded Suspect	1400 block of Michigan Ave	A suspect pushed an elderly woman, causing a deep head laceration, then barricaded himself inside an apartment armed with a knife. SWAT, CNT (Crisis Negotiation Team), CID, and PIO responded. The subject was taken into custody after a five-hour standoff.
Felony Child Abuse Arrest		CIT (Crime Impact Team) arrested a father after his child was reported to have been abused and was observed with visible injuries to their back and legs.
Impersonation of Peace Officer	1600 block of 4th St	DART (Directed Action Response Team) arrested a subject for warrants who was found wearing an "FBI" shirt, "FBI" helmet, makeshift ID cards, and a makeshift body armor vest.
Felony Warrant Arrests	Citywide	Multiple arrests were made, including a subject with a No Bail Warrant for Grand Theft and a No Bail Parole Warrant, and a suspect wanted for a Felony Battery Warrant.
Pier Jump/Arrest	West End of Pi	A subject was rescued after a pier jump attempt. Separately, a subject attempting to er jump from beneath the pier deck fell 20 feet but grabbed netting, then was arrested after a foot chase.
Animal Cruelty/Neglect Case		ACOs impounded an abandoned Great Dane found on a balcony after an eviction. The dog was found to be 60lbs underweight, and a crime report is pending a veterinarian's final assessment.

Location / Incident	Warrant Type	Offense(s)	Narrative POLICE
Palisades Park	Felony Warrant	211 PC (Robbery), 245(a)(4) PC (ADW)	A subject was contacted for smoking in the park. A wants/warrant check revealed an outstanding LAPD felony warrant for robbery and assault with a deadly weapon. The individual was arrested and transferred to LAPD custody.
Palisades Park	\$100K Warrant	23110 PC & 30305 PC	Officers contacted a subject suspected of narcotic activity. A records check showed a \$100,000 warrant from El Monte PD for multiple charges, including throwing substances at vehicles and ammunition possession. The subject was arrested on the warrant.
Walgreens (Petty Theft Call)	No Bail Warrant + Parole Warrant	Grand Theft (No Bail), Parole Violation	After detaining a shoplifting suspect, officers discovered he had a No Bail Warrant for Grand Theft and an active Parole Warrant. The individual was taken into custody.
1400 Alley 5	Multiple Warrants	Narcotics Warrants (\$75,000+)	During a patrol encounter, officers found the subject had two outstanding narcotics warrants totaling over \$75,000. The subject was arrested without incident.

HOMELESSNESS



The Homeless Liaison Program (HLP) team conducts Directed Deployment efforts at the start of each shift, focusing on specific areas throughout the city.

Below is a summary of this week's activity.



Individual Placement	An unhoused individual was successfully referred to and admitted into Samoshel for temporary housing after HLP worked with the Salvation Army to establish trust.
Couple Placement:	An unhoused couple was successfully referred to and admitted into Samoshel after building a relationship with the officers and working with the Salvation Army.
Arrest & Clinical Placement	Officers contacted two subjects in an encampment on the 2300 Block of Ocean Ave. One subject was arrested for drug violations after being found with a glass smoking pipe and a white substance. The arrestee was later placed on a mental health hold by the DMH employee assigned to the HLP Team due to being gravely disabled. The second subject was issued a citation for public camping.
Sex Registrant Arrest	Officers contacted a sex registrant who was arrested and booked for an outstanding Santa Monica warrant and failure to comply with their duty to register.



Incident Type	Location	Narrative
Reckless Driving Arrest	1800 Block Alley	Officers observed an Uber driver speeding, running stop signs, and recklessly driving near Santa Monica High School with multiple pedestrians present. Driver was arrested and the vehicle impounded.
No Bail Warrant Arrest (Traffic Stop)	4th St & Hollister Ave	Traffic stop for a stop sign violation led to the discovery that the unlicensed driver had a No Bail Warrant for Assault with a Deadly Weapon out of LAPD
Street Racing Collision (Felony Filing)	26th St & Pico	Two vehicles collided as a result of street racing. Evidence confirmed excessive speed, and the resulting injury (concussion) substantiated a felony filing submission.
DUI Arrest		Misdemeanor arrest for DUI following traffic stop.
Felony Child Endangerment / DUI	1600 block Lincoln Blvd	Driver intoxicated with children in the car.


Activity	Detail
